#### **FELIPE GARCIA**

Felipe is a seasoned musical theater director with over 20 years of experience in directing, choreography, design/set construction, and costuming. He has designed sets and costumes for the Lyric Opera Company, the Bravo Opera Company of South Texas, ProvaCoture Productions, Conservatorio de Artes Finas (CAF), Teatro Degollado, and the Laboratorio de Arte Variedades' Teatro Larva.

Most recently, he directed the acclaimed musical El Agave Rojo, which toured extensively across Mexico. Agave Rojo received praise for its compelling storytelling, innovative staging, and was invited to perform at the Daegu International Musical Festival (DIMF) in Korea.

He has served as the artistic director for ProvaCouture Productions and the Conservatorio de Artes Finas (CAF) in Guadalajara, Mexico. He had the distinct honor of being Artist in Residence directing for the symphonic orchestra Orquesta Sinfónica Juvenil de Guadalajara (OSIJUG).

In addition to his work in the performing arts, he has made significant contributions to arts education, including developing the elementary curriculum in dance and theater with KIPP school systems. He holds a Master of Science in Reading Specialization and is currently pursuing a doctoral program in Educational Psychology with an emphasis on Bilingual/ESL Education.

Now, based in Austin after many successful years in Guadalajara, he is excited to continue his artistic journey. Making his directorial debut in Georgetown, he brings a wealth of experience, creativity, and passion to the community, hoping to inspire audiences and artists alike.



## SCENIC DESIGNER/WIG STYLIST ADRIANA FONTÁNEZ

Adriana is a true jack-of-all-trades. She has designed holiday window displays for Authentic Smiles Dental Studio, Hemline, and Toy Joy in downtown Austin. She was the scenic painter for Suddenly Last Summer with Filigree Theatre and Three Musketeers with The Archive Theater, where she is also a board member. While studying at St. Edward's University, Adriana directed and fully designed Historia del Hombre Que se Convirtió en Perro. Last year, she was a replacement wig stylist for A Dickens' Christmas Carol with the Georgetown Palace Theatre, and she was thrilled to get her hands back on some wigs. Outside of her design work, Adriana also performs, choreographs, stage manages, and is a visual artist. There is nothing she loves more than engaging with a new discipline and telling a good story.







## LIGHTING DESIGNER ELBA EMICENTE SANCHEZ

Elba is a Mexican lighting artist and designer based in Austin, Texas, specializing in dance, theater, music, opera, and live performance. 
#### **INTIMACY DIRECTOR**






