

Jesee moved to Austin in 2006 after graduating from Northern Illinois University with a Bachelor of Science in Business Management (Human Resources) and a Bachelor of Fine Arts in Dance Performance and Education. Before moving to Austin, she taught ballet, pointe, modern, tap, and jazz for ten years. She was also a founding member of the award-winning competition group Petite Feet with DancEncounter in Geneva, Illinois. While attending Northern Illinois University, Jesee was the director and producer of Art for Life, an AIDS benefit concert associated with Dance for Life in Chicago.




